Board Member Opportunities

The Highwood Centre is an entertainment and event center owned by the Town of High River but administered by an autonomous Board of Directors. Four directors are appointed by corporate sponsors with five directors appointed to represent interests of the public at large. There are several public at large seats open at the present time and the Board is open to expressions of interest from community minded residents and business owners located in High River or the County of Foothills. To the extent possible, the Board should reflect the demographics of the local population.

The Highwood Memorial Centre Society is a registered not for profit organization under the Alberta Societies Act, and has charitable organization status with the Canada Revenue Agency.

Applicants for these volunteer positions must be able to demonstrate vaccine status and be willing to undergo criminal record checks.

Highwood Centre History

The citizens of High River have a long history of supporting the Highwood Memorial Centre. This pamphlet is one of the first pieces of literature sent out to area residents, asking for community and financial support, to help build a much needed community gathering place. This dedicated group was instrumental in the development of the building that has been part of many community events and milestone celebrations.

> This proposed building will serve as a practical and lasting memorial to those who heeded Canada's call to duty and will incorporate a tribute to the pioneers who established the foundations of our progress. Among facilities provided will be:

- 1. A large main auditorium suitable for theatricals, musicals and dances.
- 2. Gymnasiums and indoor sports.
- 3. Kitchen and dining rooms.
- 4. Banquets and community gatherings.
- 5. Library, reading room, children's read-ing, art and craft room.
- 6. Club rooms.
- 7. Rest rooms and lounges.

The committee appointed to investigate the feasibility of building were named at public meetings, have reviewed sites and plans, met with the council, and feel unless the ratepayers make their contribution by voting "YES" for the coming by-law, the whole idea of a community centre may have to be abandoned.

In order that this by-law sanctioning the debenture issue may be approved it must receive a two-thirds majority of the ratepayers voting. We ask that you not only vote for the by-law, but that you sup-port it actively by encouraging other rate-payers to follow your example.

The Proposed Highwood Memorial Center

The above design is the architect's conception of a suitable building to be erected on the site which has been chosen for a memorial centre for the Town of High River and District. It will provide for the facilities which are absolutely required, but it is only a preliminary outline and changes may be made in certain details before the final plans are approved.

COST!

- 1. Sale of a Debenture Issue totalling \$35,000.00, repayment spread over 20 years, necessitating the allocation of 2 mills of our present assessment. (Depending on your assessment, the average owner would pay about \$2.00 on a \$1000.00 assessment).
- 2. Public Subscription, \$35,000.00.

RETURNS!

- Title to the proposed Memorial Centre will be owned by the Town. The rate-payers will get a building costing ap-proximately \$70,000.00 for an invest-ment of only \$35,000.00. Revenue from the Memorial Centre will provide oper-ating and maintenance costs. (Deben-ture repayment by the centre would necessitate a prohibitive scale of charges). The building will be leased to the Highwood Memorial Council, an incorporated body with an elected board of management. The residents of the community will
- The residents of the community will acquire a recreational centre providing a vital need for community gathering place.
- Our youth will be provided recreational facilities under healthy, congenial surroundings.
- The establishment of such a commun-ity centre in High River will encourage the Social and Bus ness association of town and country citizens. 4.
- The inclusion of rest room facilities vill save the town the cost of providing these facilities elsewhere.
- With a building such as is proposed attractive programs for the entertain-ment and education of the people will be possible, which to date have not been available owing to lack of a suitable sudiforium. auditorium.
- The enterprise and community spirit shown in the erection of such a centre will result in publicity which will at-tract a flow of good class residents and businesses in High River.
