Not For Profit Spotlight

Rowan House

The Rowan House is a short-term women's emergency shelter serving the Foothills/southern Alberta for over 20 years. Rowan House began in 2000 as a tiny, 2-bedroom basement suite near Black Diamond. In 2003 funding was secured for Outreach services, and in 2009 we launched our Preventative Education program. Around that same time, we began a



campaign for a new, stand-alone secure shelter which opened at half-capacity in 2012. After the flood of 2013 we secured funding to open all 24-beds in shelter and have since continued to expand our current programs and services to meet the growing and changing needs of the community and the trends seen throughout the domestic violence sector.

Their mission is to provide crisis intervention, long-term support and preventative education to break the cycle of domestic abuse in our communities.
