### **FUNDRAISING**

Did you know that the Highwood Centre is managed by the Highwood Memorial Centre Society, a registered charity that is dedicated to preserving the rich history and legacy of the Highwood Centre?

The Society, comprised of passionate individuals and long-time residents, along with the Highwood Centre operations team, works tirelessly to ensure that the Centre remains a vibrant hub of community activity, offering a range of services that cater to the diverse needs of local residents. From hosting cultural events and exhibitions to providing educational workshops and social gatherings, the Highwood Memorial Centre Society is committed to fostering a sense of community and connection among residents. By supporting the Highwood Centre, the Society is not only preserving the past but also ensuring the future of the Centre for generations to come.

While most of our funding comes from product and service sales, the upkeep costs of our expansive building necessitate the additional fundraising efforts. In 2023, the Society contributed over \$330,000.00 in operating costs and over \$23,000 in physical upgrades for the Centre.

We are currently raising funds to support the acquisition of a professional audio system, enabling a broader range of live performance events and community engagement. The next fundraising phase targets an upgraded stage lighting package, which will not only enhance our capacity for live entertainment and theatre, but it will also reduce our energy consumption.

Past initiatives, like online raffles and silent auctions, have contributed to our goal, with a current 50/50 raffle in progress. Generous donations from service clubs including the Highwood Lions, Rotary Club of High River, High River Legion, have further bolstered our cause. So far, we have raised over \$62,000 towards our phase one goal of \$100,000. The second phase goal is \$150,000. Stay tuned for other fundraising events we have planned this year!







### FOOTLOOSE FESTIVAL

And so marks year 2 of the Footloose Line Dance Festival. Over 200 dancers filled the building with instructors from all over the world. With this year being such a smashing success we can't wait to see what next years festival brings.
